Satellite : 399 TV channels, 109 radio channels
Cable : 165 TV channels, 8 radio channels

Public Service Broadcaster, TRT (Turkish Radio-Television Corporation) has 7 TV channels and 10 radio channels nationwide.

5 digital satellite platforms, 4 satellite infrastructure operators, 3 cable platforms, 3 cable infrastructure operators, operate in Turkey.

Constitutional Referandum was held on 16 April 2017:

Monitoring of the broadcasting activities of the media service providers during election periods were carried out according to the decisions of High Election Board (YSK).

The studies for SKAAS (Digital Recording, Archiving and Analyzing System) Renewal Project (SKAAS Version 3) has started.



Developments in Legislation



The Law no. 6112 was amended in April 2017:

the family and child friendly programmes and Works in radio and television broadcasting services which support the physical, mental or moral development of minors and young people shall be promoted by Radio and Television Supreme Council.
